

Indelible Ink Event Is Tuesday

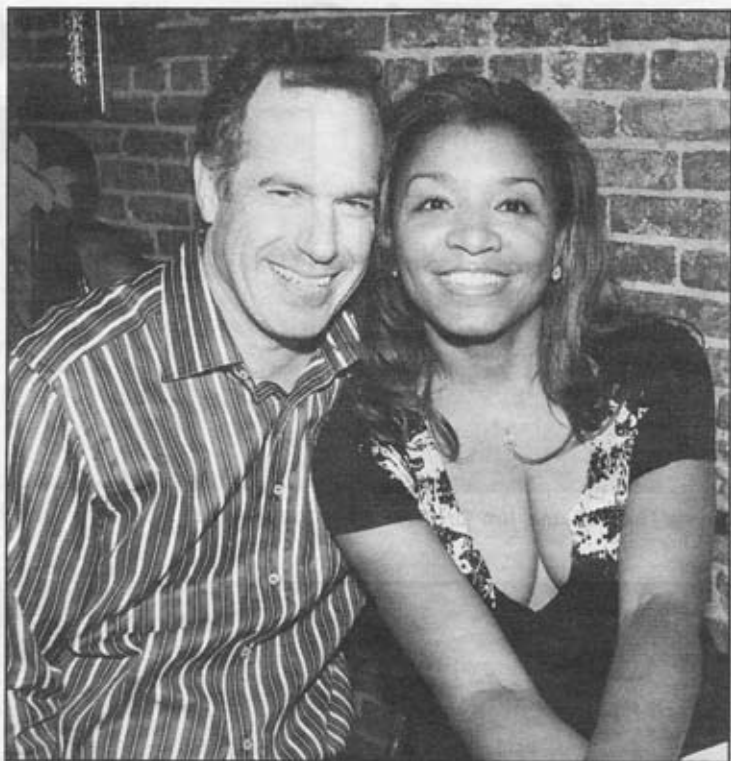
Indelible Ink will host a poetry series starting this month at Pop Champagne and Dessert Bar in Old Pasadena.

The art series starts on Tuesday, Sept. 28, at 6 p.m. It is the first of 11 shows held on the last Tuesday of each month, with the exception of December. Individual tickets are priced at \$15, and it can be purchased in advanced by calling (626) 578-7267. There is a Mark My Soul Promotion that offers two tickets, two glasses of wine, an appetizer and a book or CD of a featured performer for \$50. Pop Champagne and Dessert Bar is located at 33 E. Union Street.

Indelible Ink is a vanguard performance art series that operates under the auspices of the Pasadena Arts Council's Emerge program. Indelible Ink was conceived by host Monica Lee Copeland and its mission is to showcase performance artists whose original work is avant garde: courageous, entertaining and thought-provoking.

"We're the only show in town where one can experience music, drama, a variety act, an interview of the features, and a couple of writers all in the same lineup," Copeland said.
